Recording Desert Life

Species of particular interest include:

- Ampurta/Crest-tailed mulgara (*Dasycercus cristicauda*)
- Wilkiniti/dusky hopping mouse (*Notomys fuscus*)
- Fawn hopping-mouse (*Notomys cervinus*)
- Grey falcon (*Falco hypoleucos*)
- Woma python (*Aspidites ramsayi*)

Suspected and located in the region:

- Marsupial Mole

Please arrive with pencil, pad, camera and a willingness to observe especially at sunrise and sunset when the light assists, checking tracks on dunes. You'll find our Tracks, Scats and Other Traces books, plus other Flora and Fauna titles in the mobile Camel Treks Australia Nature Library.
